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St Kentigern Hospice is a local charity providing care and support to patients with life limiting illnesses, and their families, across North East Wales; taking in Colwyn Bay in the West along the coast to Northop in the East, and inland encompassing Abergele, Denbigh, Ruthin and Corwen.

In 2020, after 25 years of supporting the local Community, the Hospice completed a major expansion increasing the number of beds available from 8 to 12. The new Inpatient Unit reopened to the public in March 2020 providing specialist care 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. The expansion included updating the Hospice gardens, incorporating much needed office space, the build and refurbishment of the Day Therapy rooms, and the build of a new café on site.

St Kentigern Hospice provides specialist palliative care to patients and support for

Through a multidisciplinary team including nurses; doctors; a physiotherapist; a counsellor, offering both pre and post bereavement support; dementia specialists; as well as complementary and other therapists, our dedicated team will work alongside patients and their families with the aim of helping them to achieve their goals and understand what matters to them.

Ready? Set? Let's Go...

So, you're all fired up and ready to get fundraising. But where to begin? Follow these simple steps to make it easy from **start** to finish.



Get Ready

Set a target

You may already have a target for example, if you've signed up to do a sponsored challenge or event for St Kentigern Hospice. If not, setting yourself a target is a great way to stay motivated and raise more.

Decide how much you'd like to raise once you've covered any costs and tell everyone your goal. Setting up an online fundraising page such as JustGiving is a great way to stay on track and share your progress. It also makes it easier for people to donate to your fundraising.

WHEN

- The timing of your challenge or event is entirely up to you, however avoid clashes with local or national events.
- Allow enough time for any travel, accommodation or suppliers to be booked in cheaply.
- Planning your event around a special occasion, such as a baby shower or birthday party, is a great way to involve St Kentigern Hospice in your celebrations.

WHERE

Where are you going to hold your fundraising activity? Indoors or Outdoors?

Do you need to plan a route or book a venue? If so, can you get one for free? Ask local schools and community centres.

Selecting a venue depends on how many people you are planning to invite to your event. Check the venue's public liability insurance and make sure it covers the owners' liability risks.

WHO

Think about who you will be inviting to your activity and how you'll do it. Make a list of everyone who may be able to sponsor you. Spread the word with friends, colleagues and family to help you.

WHY

Tell everyone why you are fundraising and about the great work St Kentigern Hospice does in the community. Use blogs, social media and anything else you can think of.



Insurance

If you're organising your own event, unfortunately St Kentigern Hospice's public liability insurance will not cover your event and/or be liable for any loss or injury. You may need to arrange for your own insurance, unless you are covered by your own home insurance.

Branding:

If you would like personalised branded marketing materials to help promote your event such as banners, posters, balloons, and collection buckets, please contact the St Kentigern Hospice Fundraising Team who will be happy to create these for you and send them over.

Raffles and lotteries:

If your charity raffle prize is worth more than £200 or you will be selling tickets for longer than 24 hours, you may need a small lottery license. Take a look at the gambling commission website for further information. www.gamblingcommission.gov.uk
