

# TOP TIPS FOR FUNDRAISING SUCCESS

## **Try adding a few extra rounds**

## **Promote your quiz**

Ask your friends and family to promote the quiz and consider putting up posters in your local area. Remember, the more people that take part, the more money you'll raise.

## **No cheating**

On the day, make sure to let everyone know the two quiz rules: don't cheat and have fun!

## **Team names**

Get everyone to think of an inventive team name - you could even award extra points for the best one.

## **Prizes**

You need to consider what the winner will get; maybe make a certificate or provide a group prize.

## **Gift Aid**

Make sure that Gift Aid is not claimed on the money paid to take part in your quiz, as these are not donations as far as Gift Aid is concerned. Donations you receive where your supporters get nothing in return are eligible for Gift Aid, if they are made by a UK taxpayer. Get your supporters to complete your sponsorship form and claim Gift Aid where they can. It will help you raise more money for St Kentigern Hospice

## **Raffles and lotteries:**

There are strict and complex laws relating to raffles and lotteries. There are also legal requirements regarding prizes, the costs of running a raffle or lottery, and the way they are organised. Please contact your local authority for advice before holding an event like this.

## **Licences:** you will need a licence from your local authority for any of the following activities:

- Providing alcohol
- Providing entertainment
- A public collection
- Selling goods in a public place
- Putting up banners or signs in public areas

# HOSPICE INFORMATION

**St Kentigern Hospice is a local charity providing care and support for patients with a life limiting illness across North East Wales. Taking in Colwyn Bay in the west along the coast to Northop in the East and inland encompassing Abergele, Denbigh, Ruthin and Corwen.**

In 2020, after 25 years of supporting the local Community, the Hospice completed a major expansion increasing the number of beds available from 8 to 12. The new Inpatient Unit reopened to the public in March 2020 providing specialist care 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. The expansion included updating the Hospice gardens, incorporating much needed office space, the build and refurbishment of the Day Therapy rooms and the build of a new café on site.

St Kentigern Hospice provides specialist palliative care to patients and support for families to meet their individual needs. Through a multidisciplinary team including nurses, doctors, a physiotherapist, an occupational therapist, a chaplain, a social worker, a counsellor (offering both pre and post bereavement support), dementia specialists as well as complementary and other therapists, our dedicated team will work alongside patients and their families with the aim of helping them to achieve their goals, and understand what matters to them.
