Caffi Cariad is our hospice-based café with seating for 50. The café is open every day from 9.30am to 4.00pm. We serve tasty home cooked food, with a varied menu of breakfasts, lunches, afternoon teas, fresh cakes, snacks, daily specials, Paninis and hot and cold drinks. There is NO cooking or food preparation required with this role. We provide a uniform, offer free onsite parking and discounted menu. The shifts are a minimum 2 hours in duration and some volunteers do stay longer.

TASK DESCRIPTION

- To provide a warm and welcoming atmosphere for our customers.
- To ensure the tables and surrounding areas are clean and tidy.
- To take customer's orders, serve food and drinks (once the relevant training is completed).
- To load and unload the dishwasher. (Volunteers aged 16+).

Additional training is optional for the TILL and coffee machine. (Volunteers aged 16+).
